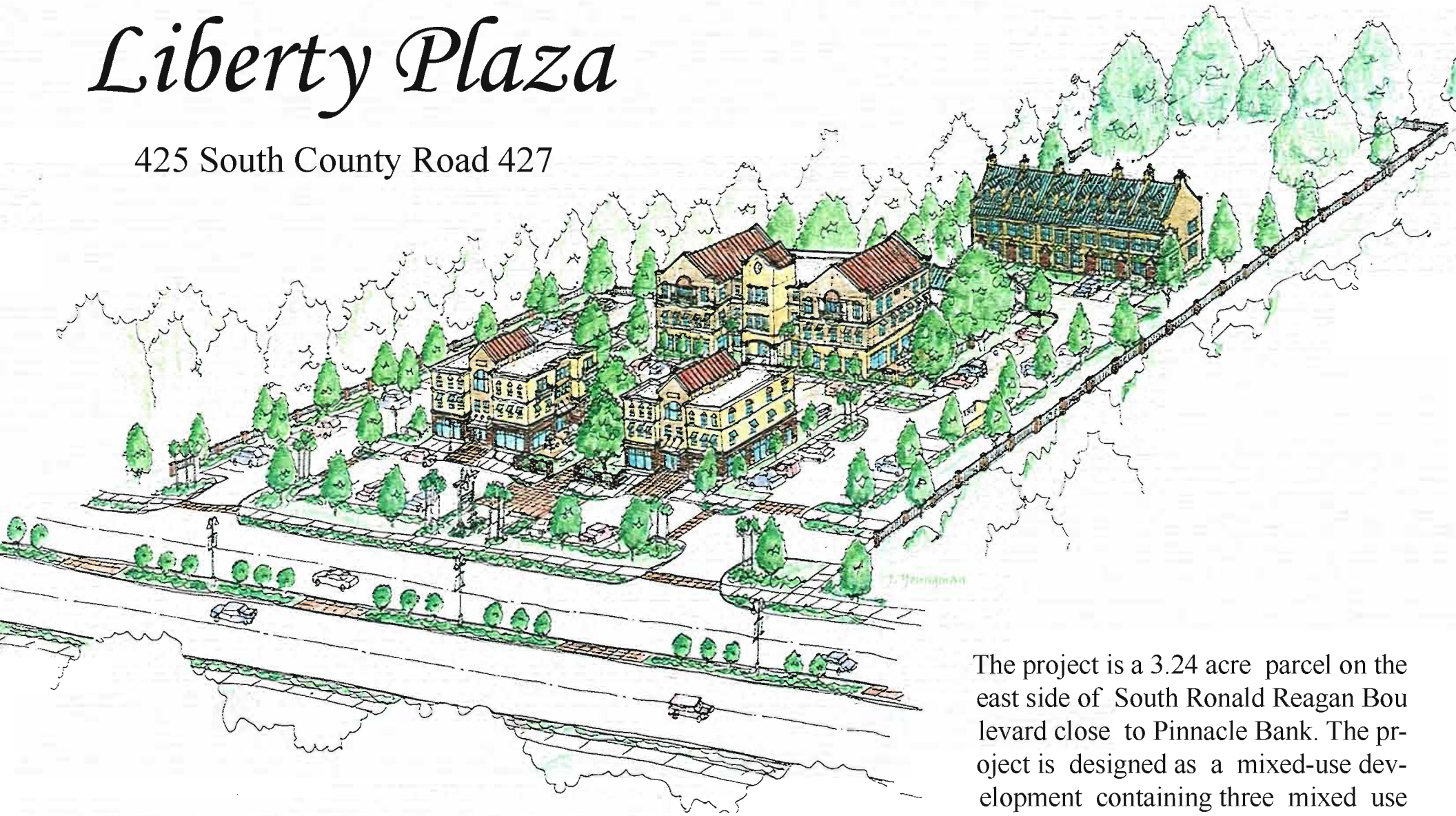

# *Liberty Plaza*

425 South County Road 427



The project is a 3.24 acre parcel on the east side of South Ronald Reagan Boulevard close to Pinnacle Bank. The project is designed as a mixed-use development containing three mixed use buildings in the front and a multi-family

building in the rear. The mixed-use buildings will each be three stories in height containing 24,800 sq. ft. of commercial/retail space on the first and second floors and eight loft style apartments on the third floor. The two front buildings will be separated by a landscaped courtyard. The multi-family residential building at the rear of the property will also be three stories in height and contain six row house style apartments. Each will be served by its own internal stairway. A portion of the rear parcel will be left in a more natural state to serve as a buffer to the residential area to the east.
