The City of Longwood's Raising Energy Efficiency Program (REEP) provides homeowners up to \$500.00 per year in financial incentives to increase their homes' energy efficiency through decreasing the demand for electricity by upgrading and replacing outdated systems.

Boost the Local Economy

When purchases are made locally, our entire community benefits! REEP rebates are available to homeowners that utilize local contractors, suppliers, vendors, or businesses located within the city limits of Longwood to make qualified home improvements.

Homeowners are eligible for a rebate of up to \$500 per year per owner-occupied residence for the following energy efficient home improvements:

- ◆ HVAC System Upgrades
- ◆ Solar Panels and Photovoltaic Systems (including pools)
- ◆ Insulation Upgrades
- ◆ Exterior Window and Door Replacements
- ◆ Window Film Installation
- ◆ Tankless Water Heaters
- ◆ Solar Water Heaters
- ◆ Roof Replacement
