

Tree Removal Application



Please provide the following for all applications:

- o Completed Permit Application
- o A site plan or survey indicating the tree to be removed. A hand-drawn map may be accepted in some situations. Surveys and maps must show existing and proposed structures and driveways, as well as proposed trees for removal (with species name and size of tree to be removed indicated). Notation of replacement trees is required, if applicable.
- o For dead or diseased tree, a photo of the tree to be removed

I am removing a live tree or have been cited by Code Enforcement:

If a Notice of Violation for illegal tree removal has been issued, there is a three-to-one replacement penalty. If a 15-inch tree was removed, the replacement amount will be the equivalent of 45-inches. This penalty may be satisfied by either the replacement or mitigation option or a combination of both.

Replacement or relocation of trees approved for removal shall be required. **Where replacement trees are allowed, the total of the inches in diameter of the replacement trees shall be equal to or greater than the total of the inches in diameter of the removed trees.** Should the applicant choose or should site conditions prevent replacement, a fee will be assessed pursuant to the attached Tree Removal Permit Fee Schedule (Resolution 09-1212). Replacement trees shall be of a similar or greater canopy and shade potential as the tree being replaced. **All trees shall be 3" DBH or greater.**
