

Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances for the City of Longwood, Florida, provides that the Mayor will issue a Proclamation giving notice of the qualification period for a special election, stating the time and polling place(s) of the special election, and stating the office(s) to be filled by the special election; and

WHEREAS, said Proclamation shall be advertised twice in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, a special election is being called hereunder for the purpose of electing a City Commissioner to fill the unexpired term of the District #2 seat that ends in November 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRIAN D. SACKETT, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA, do hereby proclaim that the City of Longwood Special Election will be held on **Tuesday, August 24, 2021**, from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Registered voters of Longwood will vote at Precinct 19: Longwood Community Building, 200 West Warren Avenue, Longwood, Florida.

This special election will be held for the purpose of electing a City Commissioner to fill the vacancy in District #2 caused by the resignation of Commissioner Richard Drummond. The winner of the special election will take office upon being sworn in after the certification of the election and serve as District #2 City Commissioner to fill the unexpired term that ends in November 2024.

The City is opting out of early voting. Voters that have a standing request for absentee ballots will receive absentee ballots from the Supervisor of Elections.

DATES OF QUALIFICATION WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: From 12:00 noon on Monday, June 7, 2021 until 12:00 noon on Friday, June 11, 2021.

ALL CANDIDATES MUST QUALIFY WITH THE CITY CLERK AT CITY HALL, CITY OF LONGWOOD, 175 WEST WARREN AVENUE, LONGWOOD, FLORIDA.
